  - (iv) CEF




#### **Remarks on short list**

- The retained proposals cover all areas listed in the Work Programme topic PHC 34. The retained proposals are:
  - eStandards (Standardization): Common reference information model for eHealth deployment
  - openMedicine (ePrescriptions): Common data model/vocabulary for medicinal or pharmaceutical products
  - ASSESS\_CT (SNOMED): Detailed analysis on the advantages and disadvantages, as well as the impact of using SNOMED CT as the core terminology at the EU level
  - VALUeHEALTH (CEF): Identification of right business models and plans which would determine sustainable sources of revenue and related costs
