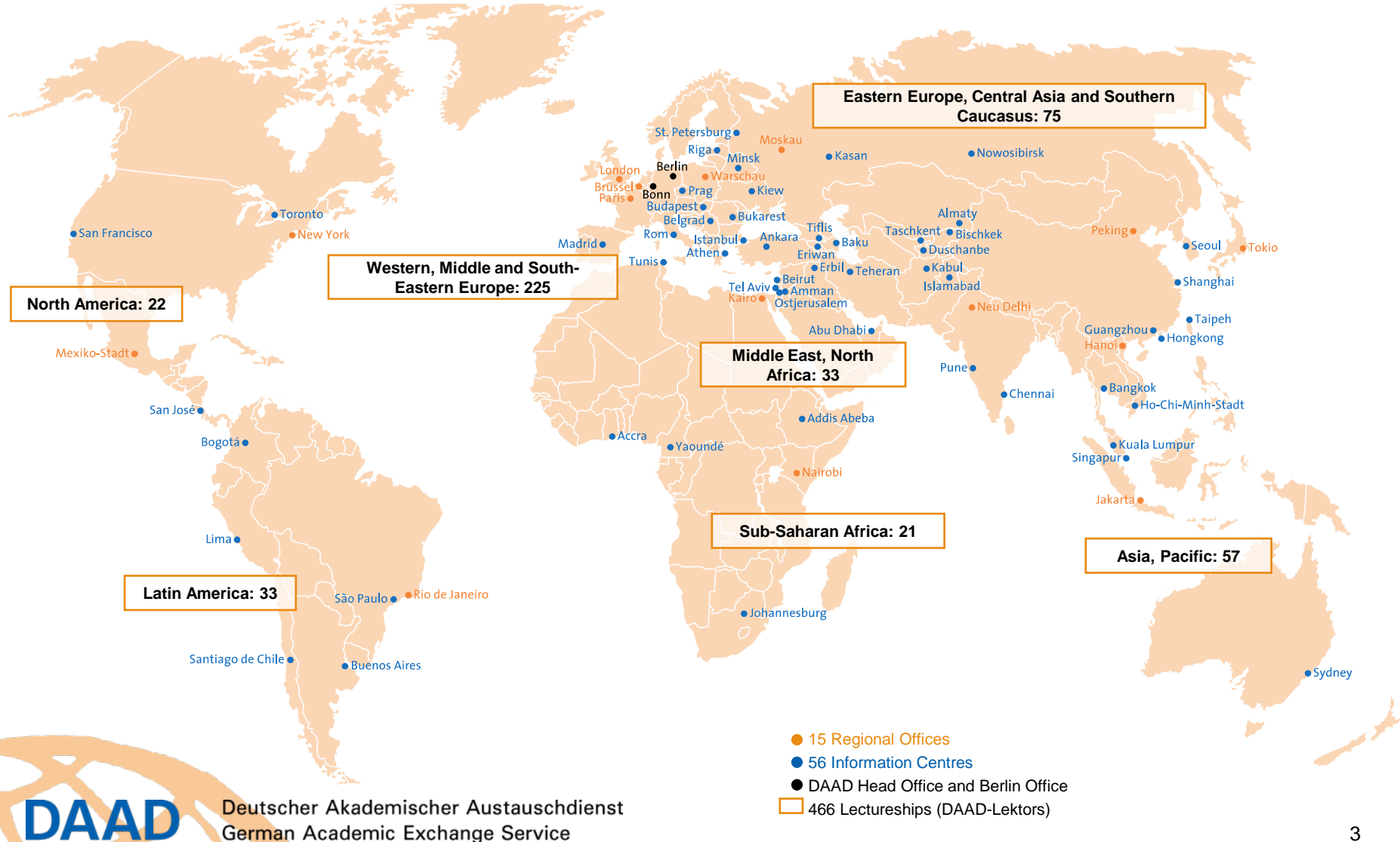
The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) is ...

A self-governing organisation of German universities:

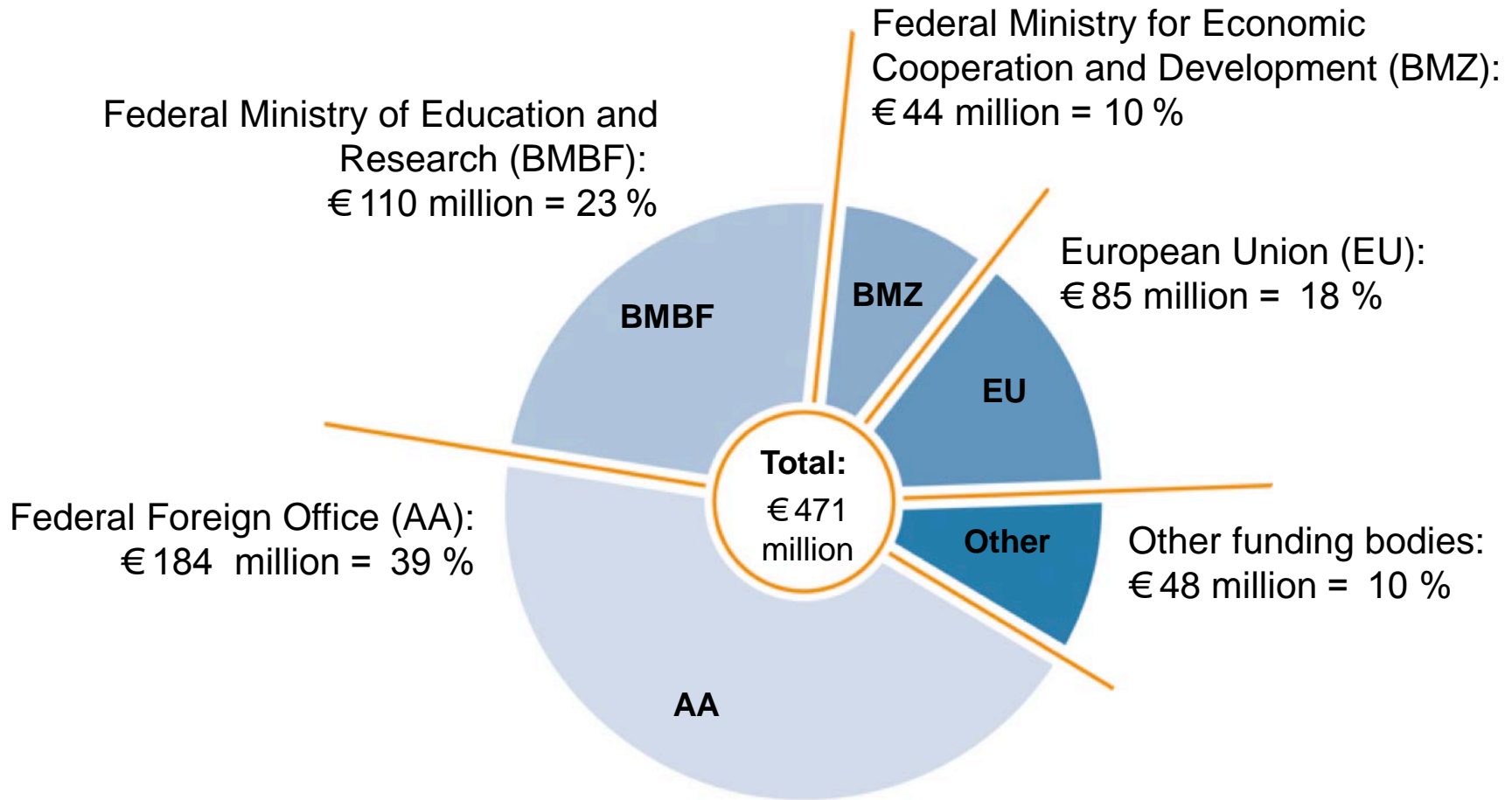
- 239 member universities

Grant scholarships to the best

STRUCTURES FOR INTERNATIONALISATION

Create structures that promote internationalisation

- so that higher education institutions can improve the quality of research and instruction and address the challenges of the future with strong partners.
- so that more people can cross borders and achieve success in study and research.
- so that German remains an important language of culture and scholarship.
- so that higher education institutions may contribute to development and build bridges to surmount conflicts.

Short-Term Grants: 1-6 months

One-Year Grants: 10 months

Requirements

- research plan
- agreement of the German supervisor (Professor)

- formal attachments (CV, 2 references, documents of education, list of publications);
- certificate of English/German language



Objectives

- gather materials for PhD-thesis
- laboratory, library, archives



Individual Scholarship Programmes – Research Grants Doctoral Programmes

up to 3 years
for PhD students/candidates

Requirements

- very solid, very carefully and substantially planned research proposal
- time schedule
- agreement of the supervisor and the faculty

- Formal attachment (CV, list of publications)
- Language certificate
