IN 2.0 New Challenges

Enlarged and redefined set of Minimum Standards and Guiding Principles for NCP

 Knowledge about other opportunities in H2020 to apply for Health and other funding programmes

Broadened thematic scope

 New disciplines merged into SC1: ICT for Ageing and ICT for Health, SSH, Environment and Health

New constituency of SC1

 New instruments like the SME instrument, innovation actions, prizes and the public procurement instruments PCI and PCP



12.0 Preliminary results

	EU-15	EU-13	AC	TC	Total
sent	51	21	14	132	218
answered	25	12	11	25	73
response rate	49,02	57,14	78,57	18,94	33,49

- the NCPs background is mostly research-oreinted (71,2% of those who answered) and 65,7% have experience in participating in FP projects as partner or coordinator
- most NCPs are neither a member of the PC of SC1 (67,1%) nor of the SRG of IMI2 (83,6%), are not national representatives of AAL2 (98,6%) or EDCTP2 (97,3%)
- and many of these are not informed about the meeting contents by the national representatives (PC SC1: 39,2% not informed, IMI2: 62,9%), AAL: 77,8%, EDCTP2: 75,7%)
- 26% are NCPs only since H2020
- 61,6% have another job besides being NCP
- 31 NCPs already expressed their interest to participate in a staff exchange, and 9 in a personalised mentoring programme!

12.0 Training courses

Programme of on-site training courses

- 2/year on-site training courses (Brussels and other country)
- Knowledge within the network (any experienced NCP can be a trainer)
- 25 seats for MS/AC NCPs + 5 TC NCP:
 - MS/AC NCP travel and accommodation arranged
 - TC NCP: at their own costs
- Next training courses:
 - "Proposal Preparation for health-related calls in Horizon 2020",
 17 June, BEA premises
 - "Legal and Financial Aspects", 28-29 October, Rome, NCP Academy (tbc)



12.0 Training courses (2)

Programme of webinars

- 8 foreseen + more upon demand
- May be opened to other NCP network, when relevance of thematic (any experienced NCP can be a trainer)
- Complement webinars of relevant support networks (FFH 2.0, Ideal IST 2018)
- Synergies with other programmes' webinars (IMI2, EDCTP2)
- First webinar 31st March: (Presentations on the website)
- HNN 2.0 kick-off and Health opportunities in Horizon 2020



N2.0 Mentoring Programme

Staff Exchanges

- Offer at least 1 NCP from each MS and AC one opportunity
- 2-day Predefined programme agreed between the participants (host and visitors)
- 3-4 NCPs per visit
- ToR, application form and EoI:
 - MS/AC NCP travel and accommodation arranged for visitors
 - MS/AC NCPs can also be host
- Continuos open call, 3 Cut-off dates per year:
 - 31 March 2015
 - 30 June 2015
 - 30 November 2015



√2.0 Mentoring Programme (2)

Mentoring for EU-13 NCPs

- Offer at least 1 NCP from each EU-13 the opportunity
- Tailored-made programme aimed at raising the success of submitted proposals
- Teaming like approach
- 8-week programme (virtual contact, VoIP (30 minutes/week for each mentee by Skype, for example), and one on-site visit (2 days, up to 3 mentees per visit).
- ToR, Eol open for Mentors and Mentees:
 - Travel and accommodation arranged for visitors
 - MS NCPs can also be host
- Continuos open call

- Space for networking and mutual learning with relevant networks
- 1 with EEN and 1 with Ideal-IST 2018
- Travel and accommodation arranged for 40 MS/AC NCPs at each workshop


In Brussels

- Application to be a host
- 1/3 events in an EU-13 country
- Open for applicants
- Free of charge
- NCP participation restricted to organizers and speakers
